Several sets of plans regarding Clopton Farm were available for perusal and comments. Council actions as below:-

S/2093/16/VC: Variation of Visibility Splays (condition 15) of application S/25811/11

Council discussed the plans at length but felt unable to come to any decision. The following comments were sent to SCDC:-

"The farm entrance has been used safely for many years. However, Council does not feel qualified to comment on Highway Safety and will be happy to accede to CCC Highways requirements."

Change of Use application number S/2059/16/PA

A carpentry workshop is proposed for the old grain store on Clopton Farm and after inspecting the plans, Council wanted to comment on this.
